©About National Health Insurance (NHI) tax

NHI tax is a valuable financial source allocated to your medical expenses. In preparation for unexpected illnesses or injured, make sure to pay your insurance tax before due date. Householders are responsible for the payment of the insurance tax.

ODetermination of NHI tax

Your NHI tax is decided based on your income for the previous year and other factors.

Olf you delinquent NHI tax

(1)If the delivery deadline is over 20 days A reminder will be sent to you.

(2)If payment is not still received

Instead of a regular NHI card, it may replace a short- term card will a one-month expiration date. You may be charged a late payment.

OHow to pay NHI tax

(1) Cash

You can use the invoices that will be enclosed with your NHI tax notice to pay at various financial institutions, post offices, Japan Post Bank branches and convenience stores, as well as the NHI Service Desks at Town office. You can also pay your NHI tax using an application on your smartphone.

(2) Direct debit bank transfer

In order to set up a direct debit bank transfer, please fill out the Request Form, hand it directly in your financial institution.
